

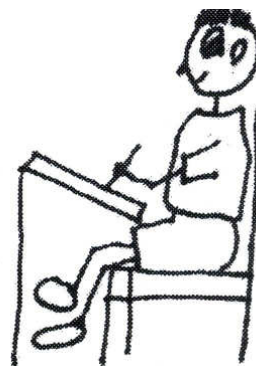
Don't Forget.

I Am!



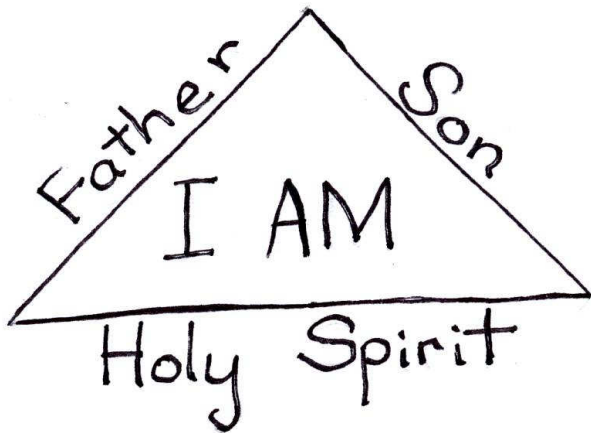
Dear Father, Son, and Holy Spirit,

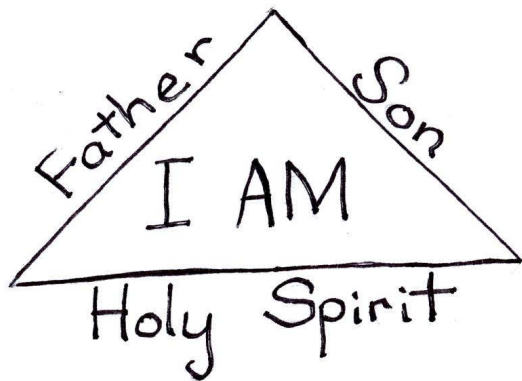
Dear Jesus,

Dear God the Father,

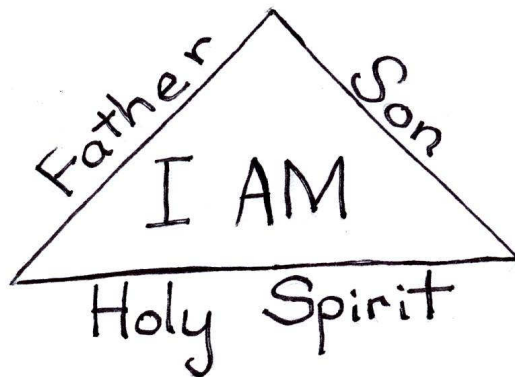
