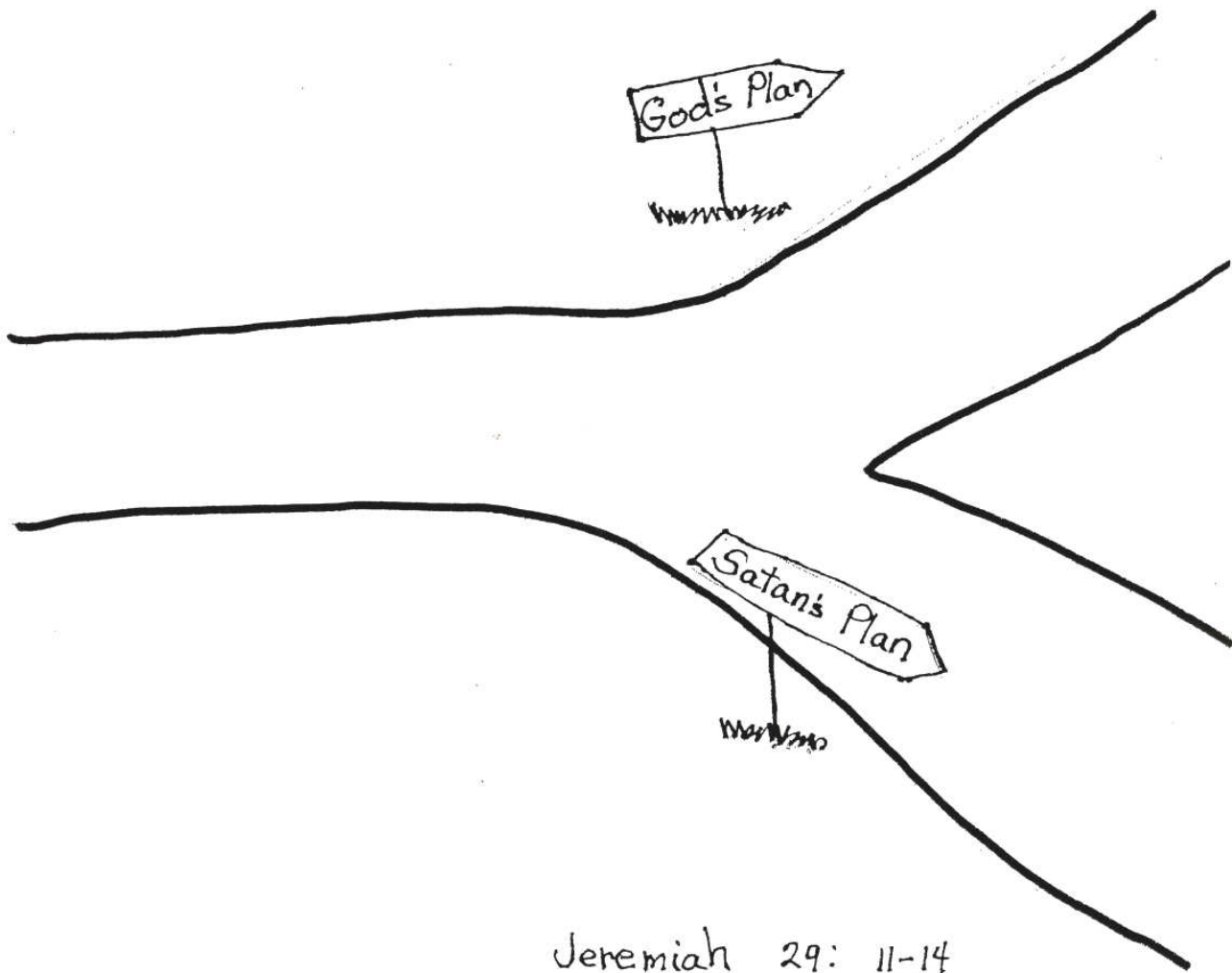


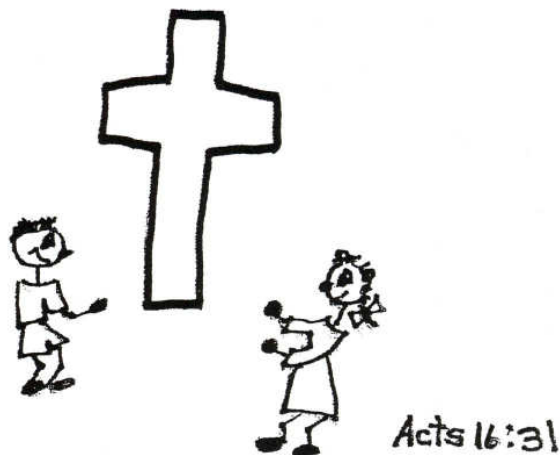
God's Plan vs. Satan's Plan

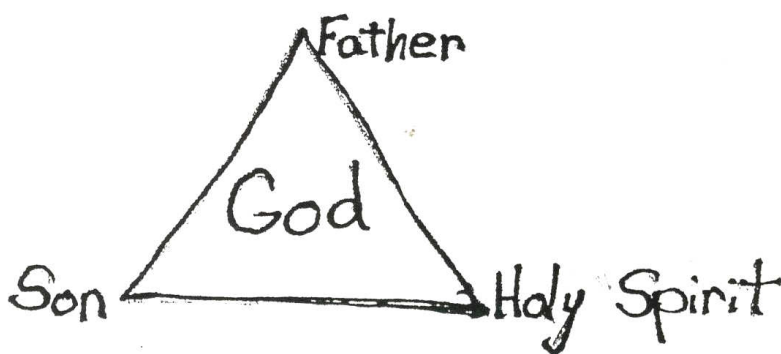


3. Learn and follow doctrine, God's way of thinking.



Psalm 118:8

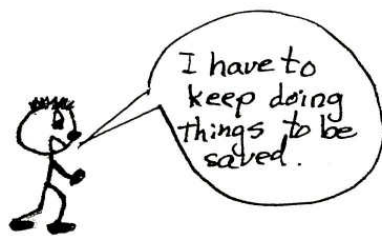
4. Spend eternity with Him in Heaven.

3. Satan wants you to be afraid,



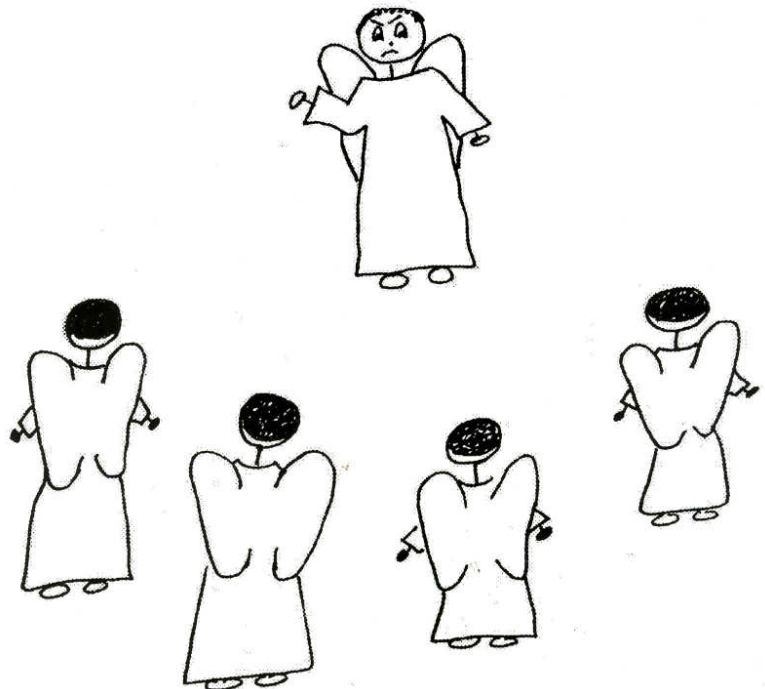
worried,



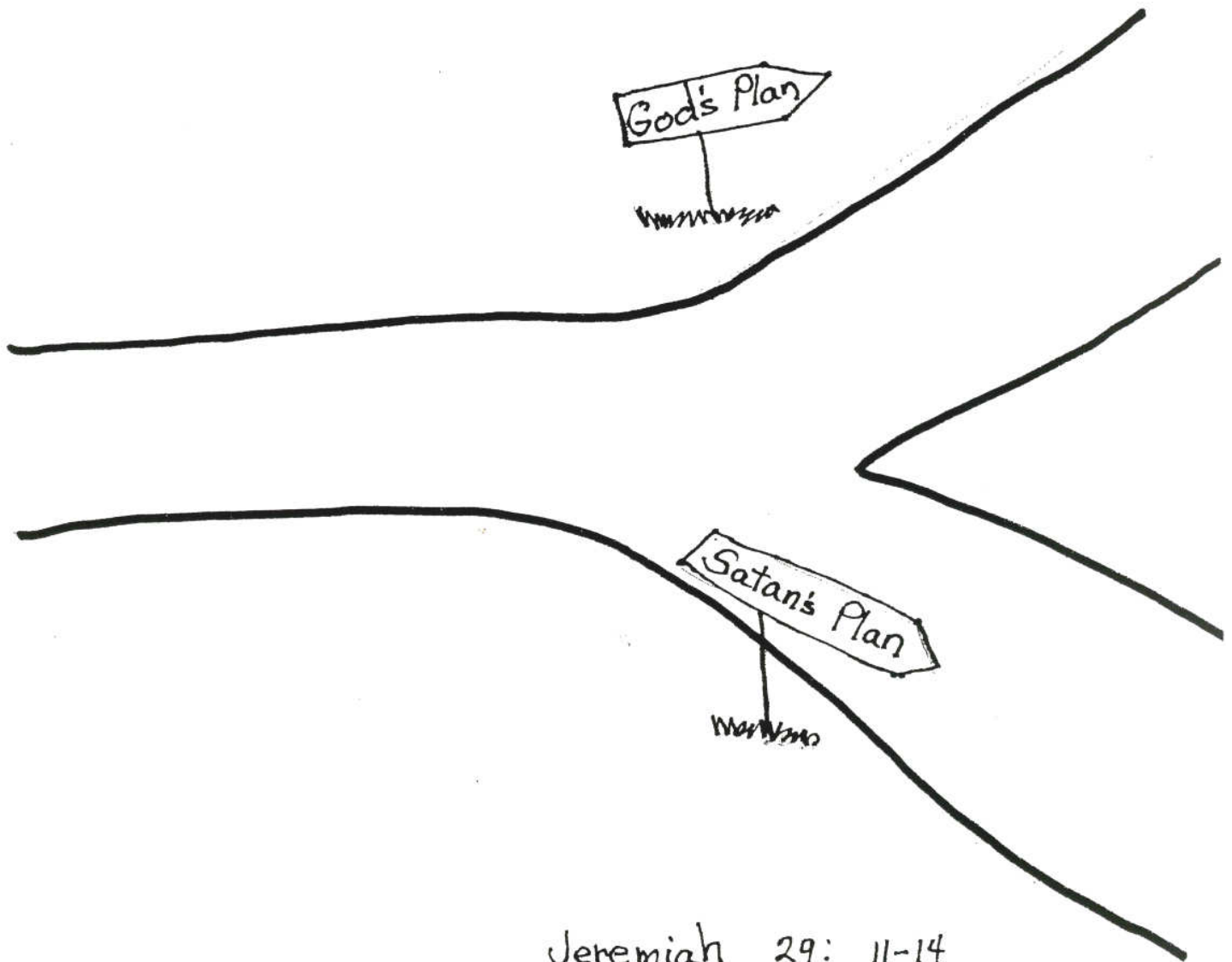
and feeling guilty.
