

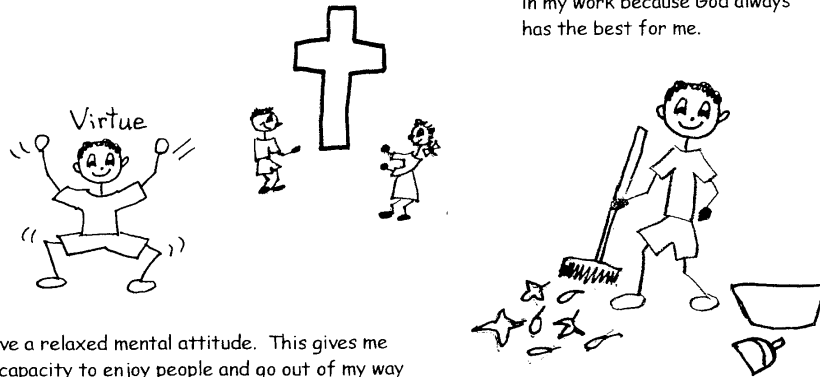
Act 1

God has given me a special job to do and I respect His plan for my life. I'm content in my work because God always has the best for me.

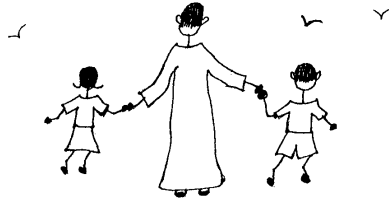

The Lord Jesus Christ is my most loyal Friend. He gave His life for me! Through His life, He teaches me to be loyal to God and people.

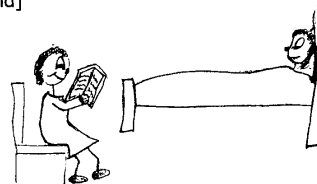
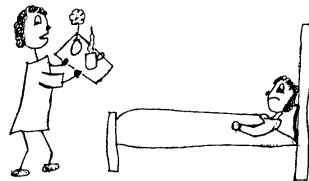

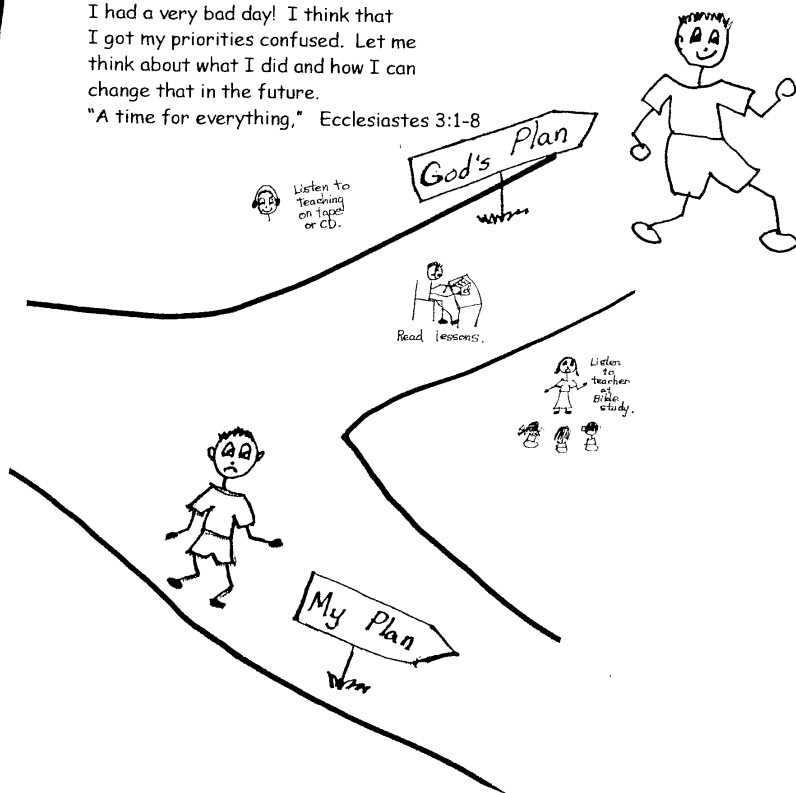
Act 3

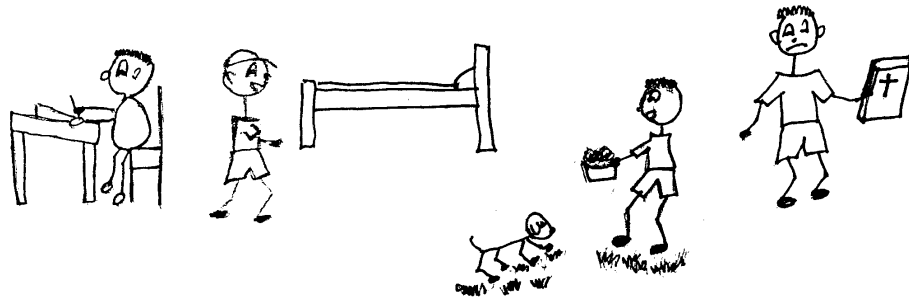
Act 4

Romans 15:4

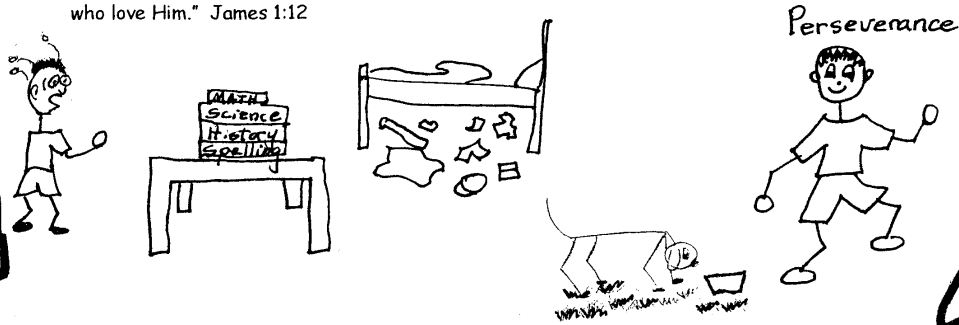
Scene 1

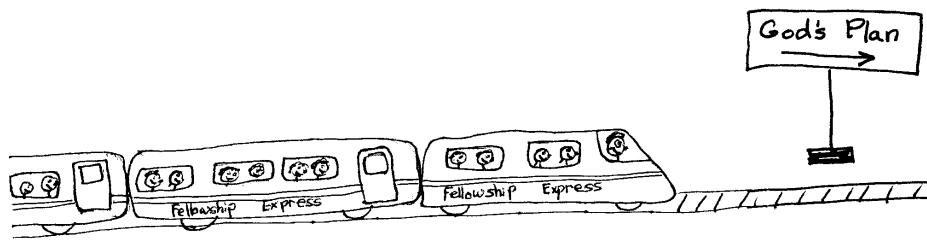


Act 5 Godliness

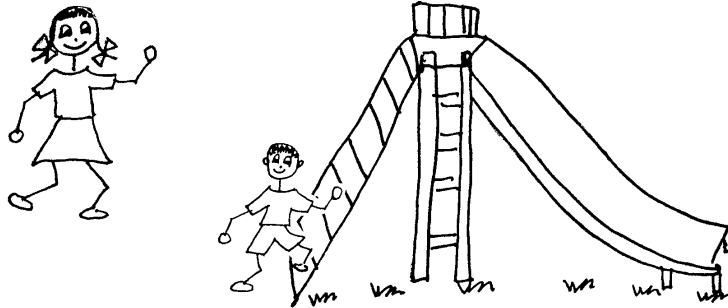
Act 6

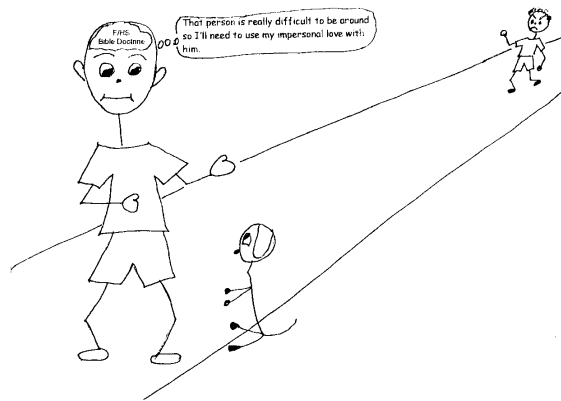
Scene 1

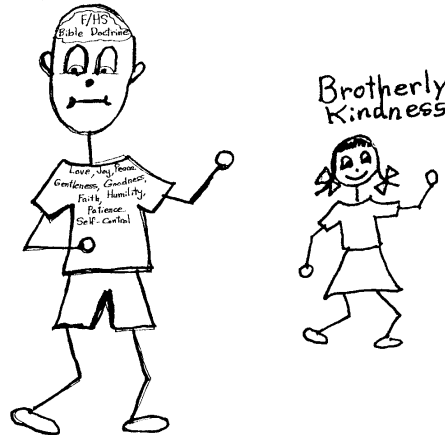
Scene 2

Act 7

Am I going to let that happen and keep a relaxed mental attitude or am I going get upset and let it take away my peace of mind?

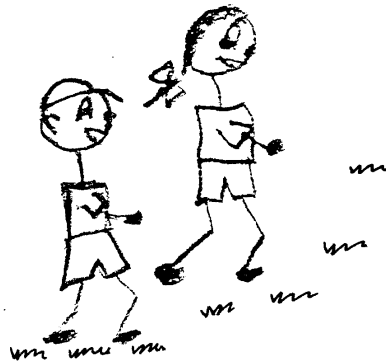

1Corinthians 13:4-5

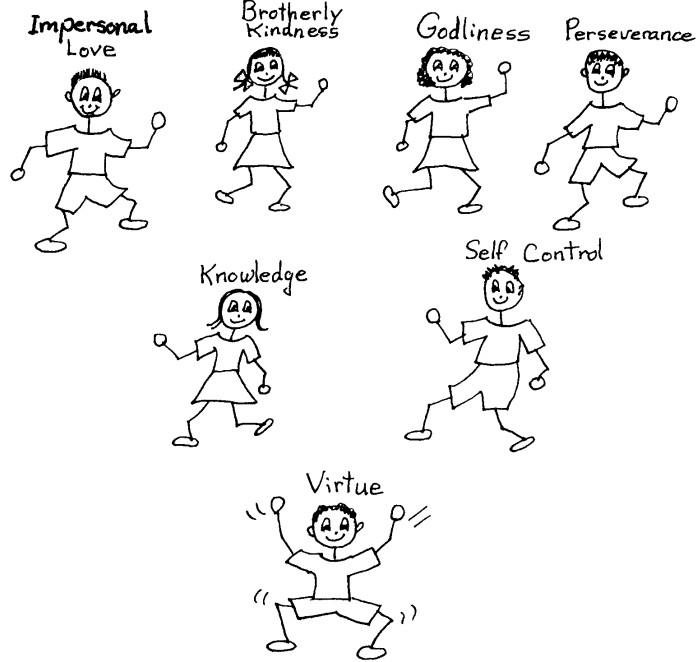

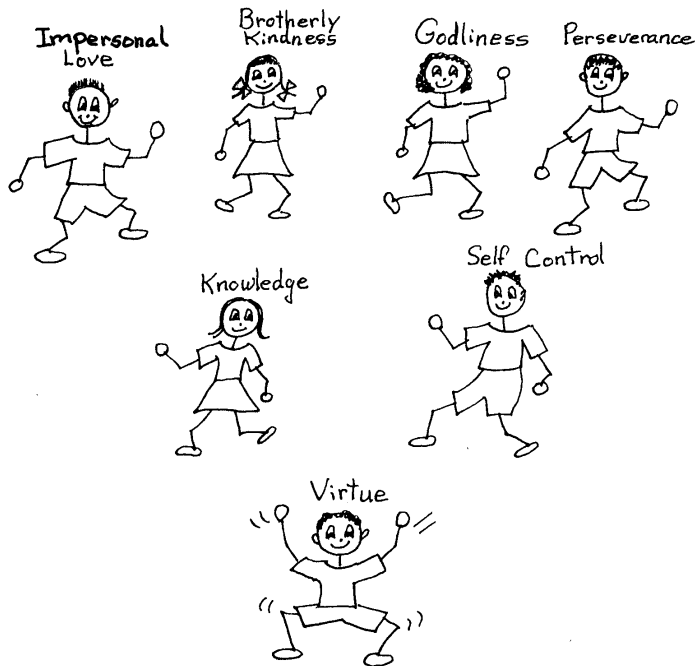
Finale
