# Biblical Humility Being Truly Humble



#### To Take In The Word Of God


True humility is an attitude in our soul. We can only get it through the power of the Holy Spirit and the word of God. It is supernaturally produced by God the Holy Spirit using the word of God. ## Submit To Its Authority



## Orient Or Adjust To God's Grace




If it was necessary for Jesus to learn humility, it is definitely necessary for us!

Psalm 25:9 He leads the humble in what is right, and teaches the humble His way.


We need to adjust to or follow God's will, not our own will. We can only understand God's will for us by learning His thinking! We can't become humble on our own; we need God the Holy Spirit to change our thinking to that of Jesus Christ. The word of God is the truth that will set us free from our old sin natures and the cosmic system. Our old sin natures and the cosmic system hate God and His thinking. 


#### Points To Remember
