

## Even When God's Commands Seem Unusual,



1 John 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments: and His commandments are not burdensome.






In the Old Testament, Joshua was told how to defeat the people of Jericho. The city of Jericho was all closed in behind walls and the people could not go out and no one could come in. They thought they were protecting themselves from the sons of Israel. However, God wanted the sons of Israel to take the city. The way He wanted them to do this was very different from what we would think!

Joshua 6:3-5 "You shall march around the city, all the men of war circling the city once. You shall do so for six days. Also seven priests shall carry seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark; then on the seventh day you shall march around the city seven times, and the priests shall blow the trumpets. It shall be that when they make a long blast with the ram's horn, and when you hear the sound of the trumpet, all the people shall shout with a great shout; and the wall of the city will fall down flat, and the people will go up every man straight ahead."




Joshua obeyed God and the walls of Jericho came tumbling down! Sometimes when God tells us how to defeat our "enemies" we think He must be kidding. Then we want to take things into our own hands; we want to be in charge. We think we can do the job better than God can. Woops! Wrong idea! God is telling us to put things in His hands and realize that He is in charge. He wants us to follow His plans for our lives. God will knock down our "walls". He will guide our ways!

"Be still, and know that I am God." Psalm 46:10



Our biggest enemy is our flesh - sometimes called our old sin nature or our old man. God tells us how to defeat this enemy. He wants us to lay aside or stop doing what we were used to doing in our old man - in our former manner of life. He wants us to live in the new man in union with Jesus Christ. In order to lay aside or put away our old man, we have to be renewed in our mind. This happens when the Holy Spirit changes our old ways of thinking through the Word of God. 

Jericho.


