Psalm 23:3 He restores my soul [rebound]; He guides me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake [for His reputation].

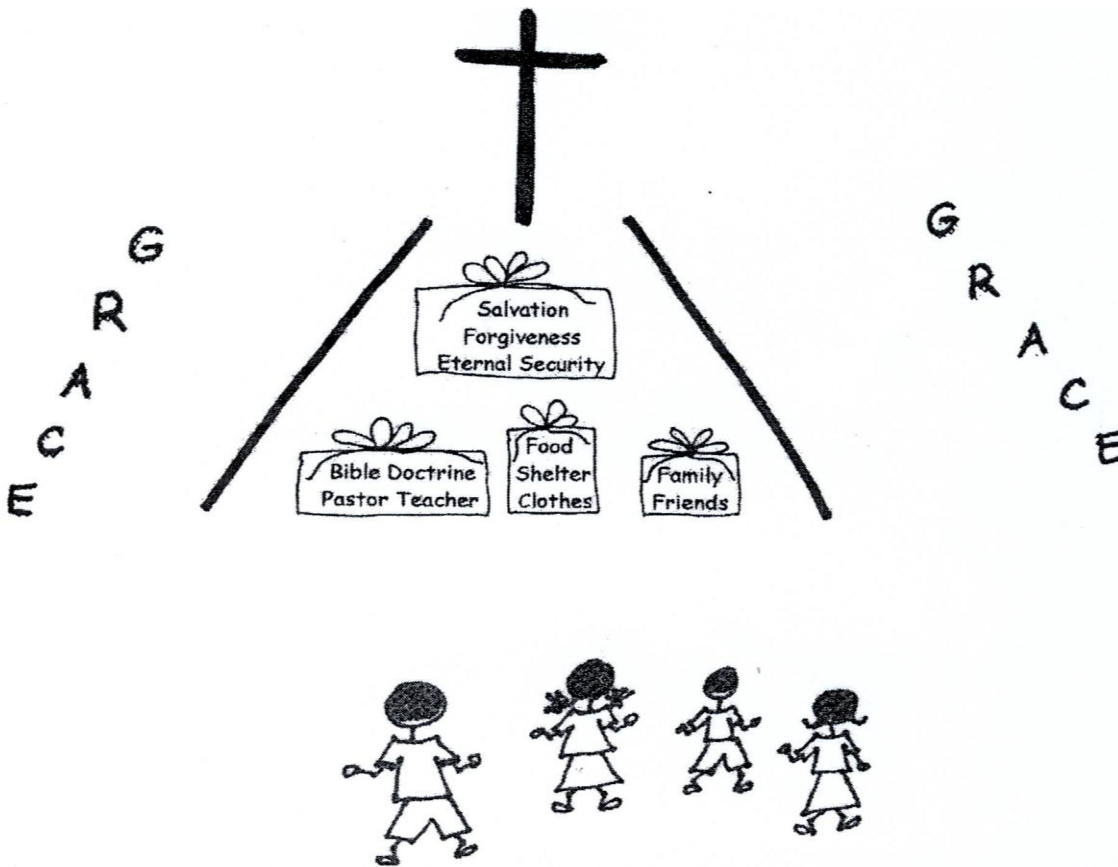
We are not to feel obliged to God to pay back anything He gives us in grace. Grace wouldn't be grace - a free gift - if we were obliged to pay God back! Feeling obliged just stands in the way of His grace. There are no strings attached to God's grace! God doesn't say, "_____ (put in your name), I will give you this grace blessing, but you have to pay for it." Jesus Christ already paid for all of our grace blessings by His work on the cross! We don't glorify God when we put ourselves under obligation. He is glorified when He delivers us from problems with His free gifts of grace. Instead of feeling obliged, we just need to say, "Thank You, God!"*
