
Grace - Freedom

Guilt - Bondage?




Galatians 5:1 It was for freedom that Christ set us free; therefore keep standing firm and do not be subject again to a yoke of slavery.

GUILT is bondage! It is a weight that stops our growth in the spiritual life. Satan uses GUILT to keep us from growing near to God and His GRACE. Satan wants us to focus on what we do rather than on what God did for us at the cross. Satan wants us to be in his bondage rather than in God's freedom! He tries to get us away from GRACE and truth since it uncovers his deception. Satan is a liar! God's word uncovers Satan's tricks.




John 8:44 He[Satan] was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth because there is no truth in him. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *nature*, for he is a liar and the father of lies. When we became believers in the Lord Jesus Christ, we were put into union with Him by God the Holy Spirit! We became a new person IN CHRIST!\* What a great place to be! Because our position is in Christ, we are acceptable to God. There is nothing that we can do to earn that place or to lose it. That's GRACE! Grace is free, unmerited love and favor from God. He doesn't give it to us because of our human works or because we are attractive to Him. God gives us grace because of Jesus Christ's work on the cross. God wants us to live in His grace!




Ephesians 2:4-9 But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.
