
1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 Rejoice always; pray without ceasing; in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while were were yet sinners, Christ died for us.



Romans 12:12 Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.


